



## **Travel to Stornoway**

### **Stornoway can be reached by:**

Air from Glasgow, Aberdeen, Edinburgh and Inverness or via Barra and Benbecula. Operators are Loganair, FlyBe and BA. The flight time from Glasgow, for example, is about an hour and there are several flights daily. The airport is a ten minute drive from the town with bus and taxi links.

Train/ Coach/ Ferry - from Inverness station by coach <http://www.citylink.co.uk> to Ullapool (journey time 1 hour 20 minutes) timed to catch the Calmac Ferry [www.calmac.co.uk](http://www.calmac.co.uk) to Stornoway (journey time 2 hours 30 minutes) and with luggage checked through. The ferry terminal is a five minute walk from the marina.

Car either to catch the direct Ullapool/ Stornoway ferry or by crossing to the Outer Hebrides further south by ferries to Barra, Loch Boisdale, Loch Maddy or Tarbert.

### **Inverness can be reached by:**

Air from half a dozen UK airports with EasyJet, FlyBe, Loganair and BA and from Amsterdam with KLM [www.klm.com](http://www.klm.com)

Coach from Perth, Stirling, Edinburgh and Glasgow with CityLink

Train from Glasgow and Edinburgh with Scotrail [www.scotrail.co.uk](http://www.scotrail.co.uk) with connections from London and other UK cities.
